IN 2018, A SEASON DEFINED BY ABUNDANCE AND GENTLE RIPENING, OUR SECOND GENERATION VINES GIFTED US AN ENCHANTING WINE THAT REFLECTS THE SAME SENSE OF EASE THAT CARRIED US THROUGH HARVEST.

THIS INTRIGUING, REFINED EXPRESSION OF CABERNET OPENS WITH AROMAS OF VIOLETS, BRAMBLE, AND CHERRY, WHILE THE PALATE IS MARKED BY AN INVITING CORE OF WILD BLUEBERRY AND SNAPPY POMEGRANATE. SURROUNDING LAYERS PRESENT THE COMPLEXITY OF OUR SAVORY MOUNTAIN GARRIGUE AND A SUBSTANTIVE FINISH.
